The École Nationale des Ponts et Chaussées and the alumni association (Ponts Alumni) are launching a call for projects aimed at start-ups seeking to benefit from workstations in a coworking space at STATION F, a 34,000-square-meter classified building in the heart of Paris, transformed into the world's largest start-up campus.

This space is divided into several areas, the most prominent being the start-up zone. Located at the center, it includes 3,000 workstations and hosts international programs. Facebook, Veepee, Microsoft, HEC, and Arts et Métiers all have their own incubators there.

Station F also features an event space that includes a 360-seat auditorium, a Fab Lab, meeting rooms, private offices, and a restaurant with around 1,000 seats, open 24/7.
